### Recent Activities and News

- **CoMAH Strategic Forum**  
Work beginning on where we want to be in 5 years' time:
  - World class safety/process safety record for UK major hazard sectors
  - Better Regulation Programme improvements are bedded in, fully implemented, and delivering benefits
  - Principles of Process Safety Leadership continue to underpin industry approach to managing risk
  - Improvements to Land Use Planning & Consents framework
  - Timeliness with regulatory communications on enforcement decisions and interventions

- **New CDOIF Guidance**  
The Chemical and Downstream Oil Industries Forum (CDOIF) will shortly be starting work on 'Human Factors Improvement Techniques'.
